



**How does aging or stroke affect remembering...  
...what you had for breakfast?

We are currently recruiting **adults ages 50 and older** with no known neurodegenerative disease to study how aging affects different types of memory and learning. It is ok if you have had a stroke.

This study is non-invasive, and involves reaching and grasping everyday objects. You will come in for up to 4 visits and a one month follow-up. This study may also involve a scan of your brain with magnetic resonance imaging (MRI). Each visit will last about 1-1.5 hours.

**Participation in this study is voluntary.** If you choose to participate, you will be compensated \$30 per visit, including the MRI visit.
